Kingsbridge takes its name from an ancient bridge built to link two royal estates, Alvington and Chillington. By 1219 it was a market town. By the 18th Century milling was a major source of revenue for the town, and throughout the 19th Century Kingsbridge had an active coastal shipping trade, with thriving shipbuilding and tanning industries
