RNLI Boots

Use size 10/3 ¼ mm needles

Cast on 29 stitches using black wool

First row: Knit one row

Second row: K13, inc in next st., K1, inc in next st, K13 (31 sts)

Third row: k13, inc in next st., K3, inc in next st, K13 (33 sts).

Change to yellow wool and work 4 rows in st st

Shape toe

Next row: K20, K2 tog through back of loops (TBL), turn

Next row: SI 1, P7, P2 tog, turn

Next row: SI 1, K7, K2 tog TBL, turn

Next row: SI 1, P7, P2 tog, turn

Repeat last 2 rows until 7 sts remain on each side of toe shaping

Shape ankle

Next row: SI 1,knit to end

Next row: p7, turn

Next row: SI 1,knit to end

Next row: purl

Next row: K7 turn

Next row: Sl 1, purl to end. (23 st)

Work leg


Work 12 rows SS*


Work 4 rows of RNL1 (below)

Work 2 rows SS

Work 3 rows K

Cast off knitwise





Row 1: K4Y then B Y B B B Y B Y Y B Y B Y B then Y Y Y to end of row

Row 2: P5Y then BBYYBYBYBYYYB then YYYY to end of row

Row 3: K4Y then BYYYBYBYBYBYBYBHenYYYY to end of row

Row 4: P5Y then B B B Y B Y Y B Y B Y Y Y B then Y Y Y Y to end of row
